Holy Week programme

In last week's second reading St. Paul urged us to be conformed to the death of Christ, and in today's liturgy we come face to face with that death. In it, Jesus shows us the way of: generosity, nonviolence and compassion. At the Last Supper, he told his disciples that his death will be a total and complete gift of self.

Holy Thursday 18/04/19 - Holy Mass at 7:30pm. During this Mass the feet of 12 persons (symbol of 12 Apostles) will be washed - Please volunteer to be one of them. The Eucharistic Ministers will renew their commitment to serve.

Good Friday 19/04/19 our **Stations of the Cross** will be at **2:00 pm**. Starts inside church and have a short walk to the Calvary where we shall conclude the stations. **At 3:00pm** we shall gather together again to celebrate the Passion of the Lord, Venerate the Cross and receive the Holy Eucharist.

Holy Saturday 20/04/19 - Easter Vigil Mass at 8:00pm. Starting with the blessing of the fire and lighting of the Paschal Candle, to be followed by the official reception of new members to the faith.

Easter Sunday 21/04/19: Masses as normal Sunday 9:00am and 11:15am.
