Monday, 10th June

**MEMORIAL OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY,
MOTHER OF THE CHURCH**



This celebration was instituted in 2018 and then added to the General Roman Calendar. The Decree states: 'This celebration will help us to remember that growth in Christian life must be anchored to the Mystery of the Cross, to the oblation of Christ in the Eucharistic Banquet and to the Mother of the Redeemer and Mother of the Redeemed, Virgin who makes her offering to God.'

Entrance Antiphon: **Blessed are you, O Virgin Mary, by the Lord God Most High, above all women on earth; for he has so exalted your Name that your praise shall be undying on our lips.**

First Reading: Genesis 3:9-15.20 (LIII 841)
I will make enemies of your offspring and the offspring of the woman.

Alternate First Reading: Acts 1:12-14
They joined in continuous prayer with Mary, the Mother of Jesus.

Responsorial Psalm: **You are the highest honour of our race!**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! Blessed are you, holy Virgin Mary and most worthy of all praise, for the sun of justice, Christ our God, was born of you. Alleluia!**

Gospel: John 19: 25-27
This is your Son, this is your mother.

Communion Antiphon: **The angel Gabriel was sent from God to a virgin, and the virgin's name was Mary.**

Tuesday, 11th June

St Barnabas, Apostle

Barnabas was a Jew who came from Cyprus and became one of the first converts in Jerusalem. He introduced Paul to the Apostles and worked with him on his missions. His death is unrecorded but his remains were discovered on this day in the 5th century.

Entrance Antiphon: **Blessed is this holy man, who was worthy to be numbered among the Apostles, for he was a good man, filled with the Holy Spirit and with faith.**

First Reading: Acts 11:21-26; 13:1-3
He was a good man, filled with the Holy Spirit and with faith.

Responsorial Psalm: **The Lord has shown his salvation to the nations.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! Go, make disciples of all the nations, says the Lord; I am with you always, yes, to the end of time. Alleluia!**

Gospel: Matthew 10:7-13
You received without charge, give without charge.

Communion Antiphon: **I no longer call you slaves, because a slave does not know what his master is doing. But I have called you friends, because I have told you everything I have heard from my Father.**

Wednesday, 12th June

Entrance Antiphon: **The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The Lord is the stronghold of my life; whom should I dread? When those who do evil draw near, they stumble and fall.**

First Reading: 2 Corinthians 3:4-11
God is the one who has given us the qualifications to be the administrators of the new covenant, which is not a covenant of written letters but of the Spirit.

Responsorial Psalm: **You are holy, O Lord our God.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! Make me grasp the way of your precepts, and I will muse on your wonders. Alleluia!**

Gospel: Matthew 5:17-19
I have come not to abolish the Law of the Prophets but to complete them.

Communion Antiphon: **The Lord is my rock, my fortress, and my deliverer; my God is my saving strength.**

Thursday, 13th June

**FEAST OF OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST,
THE ETERNAL HIGH PRIEST**

The Feast of Our Lord Jesus Christ, the Eternal High Priest, according to the order of Melchizedek. In him the Father has been well pleased from before all time. As Mediator between God and human beings, fulfilling his Father's will, he sacrificed himself once on the altar of the Cross as a saving Victim for the whole world. Thus instituting the pattern of an everlasting sacrifice, with a brother's kindness he chose, from among the children of Adam, men to augment the priesthood, so that, from the sacrifice continually renewed in the Church, streams of divine power might flow, whereby a new heaven and a new earth might be made, and throughout the whole universe there would be perfected what no eye has seen, nor ear heard, nor has entered into the human heart.

Entrance Antiphon: **Christ, Mediator of the New Covenant, has an eternal priesthood because he remains forever.**

The **Gloria** is said.

First Reading: Isaiah 6:1-4, 8.
Holy, Holy, Holy Lord of hosts.

Alternative First Reading: Hebrews 2:10-18
He who sanctifies and those who are sanctified have all one origin.

Responsorial Psalm: **The Lord is my shepherd; there is nothing I shall want.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! I will pour clean water upon you and I will give you a new heart; a new spirit I will put within you. Alleluia!**

Gospel: John 17:1-2,9, 14-26
For their sake I consecrate myself, so that they may also be consecrated in truth.

Communion Antiphon: **And behold, I am with you always, even to the end of the age.**
