**Monday, 24<sup>th</sup> June**

**SOLEMNITY OF THE BIRTH OF  
ST JOHN THE BAPTIST**

Entrance Antiphon: **A man was sent from God, whose name was John. He came to testify to the light, to prepare a people fit for the Lord.**

The **Gloria** is said.

First Reading: Isaiah 49:1-6

*I will make you the light of the nations so that my salvation may reach to the ends of the earth.*

Responsorial Psalm: **I thank you for the wonder of my being.**

Second Reading: Acts of the Apostles 13:22-26  
*Jesus, whose coming was heralded by John.*

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! As for you, little child, you shall be called a prophet of god, the Most High. You shall go ahead of the Lord to prepare his ways before him. Alleluia!**

Gospel: Luke 1:57-66. 80

*His name is John.*

The **Creed** is said.

Communion Antiphon: **Through the tender mercy of our God, the Dawn from on high will visit us.**

Tuesday, 25<sup>th</sup> June

Entrance Antiphon: **The Lord is the strength of his people, a saving refuge for the one he has anointed. Save your people, Lord, and bless your heritage, and govern them for ever.**

First Reading: Genesis 13:2. 5-18  
*Let there be no dispute between me and you, for we are brothers.*

Responsorial Psalm: **The just will live in the presence of the Lord.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! Blessed are you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, for revealing the mysteries of the kingdom to mere children. Alleluia!**

Gospel: Matthew 7:26. 12-14  
*Always treat others as you would like them to treat you.*

Communion Antiphon: **The eyes of all look to you, Lord, and you give them their food in due season.**

Wednesday, 26<sup>th</sup> June

Entrance Antiphon: **The Lord is the strength of his people, a saving refuge for the one he has anointed. Save your people, Lord, and bless your heritage, and govern them for ever.**

First Reading: Genesis 15:1-12. 17-18  
*Abraham put his faith in God, and his faith was considered as justifying him. The Lord made a Covenant with Abraham.*

Responsorial Psalm: **The Lord remembers his covenant for ever.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! Because of your love give me life, and I will do your will. Alleluia!**

Gospel: Matthew 7:15-20  
*You will be able to tell them by their fruits.*

Communion Antiphon: **The eyes of all look to you, Lord, and you give them their food in due season.**

Thursday, 27<sup>th</sup> June

Weekday or

**St Cyril of Alexandria, Bishop and Doctor of the Church**

*Cyril was a defender of the faith at the Council of Ephesus and fought against heresy as a great defender of the mystery of the Incarnation and the dogma of Mary's Divine Motherhood. He is a Doctor of the Church and died in 444.*

Entrance Antiphon: **The Lord is the strength of his people, a saving refuge for the one he has anointed. Save your people, Lord, and bless your heritage, and govern them for ever.**

First Reading: Genesis 16:1-12. 15-16  
*Hagar bore Abram a son, and Abram gave him the name Ishmael.*

Responsorial Psalm: **O give thanks to the Lord for he is good.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! The word of God is something alive and active; it can judge secret emotions and thoughts. Alleluia!**

Gospel: Matthew 7:21-29  
*The house built on rock and the house built on sand.*

Communion Antiphon: **The eyes of all look to you, Lord, and you give them their food in due season.**

Friday, 28<sup>th</sup> June

**SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST SACRED HEART OF JESUS**

Entrance Antiphon: **The designs of his heart are from age to age, to rescue their souls from death, and to keep them alive in famine.**

The **Gloria** is said.

First Reading: Ezekiel 34:11-16  
*I myself will pasture my sheep, I myself will show them where to rest.*
