As long as he lives, there are always people who are better than him;

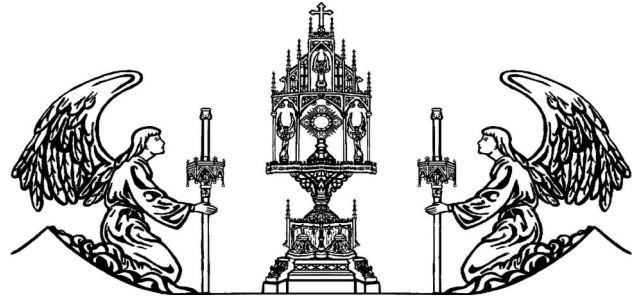
