**OUR LADY OF WALSINGHAM DOWRY TOUR: ST. CHAD'S CATHEDRAL, BIRMINGHAM** During the course of 2018 to 2020 the statue of Our Lady from the Slipper Chapel at the Catholic National Shrine in Walsingham is being taken to each Cathedral in England for a three-day triduum of prayer, as part of the preparation for the re-dedication of England as the Dowry of Mary in 2020. Each visit takes place between a Thursday and Saturday. The statue visited Our Lady of the Assumption in London (the ordinariate's 'home') in March, and will be coming to St. Chad's Cathedral in Birmingham 20<sup>th</sup>-22<sup>nd</sup> June this year. **ASCENSION DAY** Remember that the Solemnity of the Ascension of Our Lord is celebrated again on the Thursday after the Sixth Sunday of Easter, and is a Holyday of Obligation. Please endeavour to be at our Solemn Mass at 7pm on Thursday 30<sup>th</sup> May.
