### Second Collection 15th/16th June Day for Life

Day for Life is the day in the Church's year dedicated to raising awareness about the meaning and value of human life at every stage and in every condition. The Church teaches that life is to be nurtured from conception to natural death.

The proceeds of the Day for Life collection to be held in parishes in England and Wales assists the work of the Anscombe Bioethics Centre and other life-related activities supported by the Church.

The Anscombe Bioethics Centre is a Roman Catholic academic institute that engages with the moral questions arising in clinical practice and biomedical research. It brings to bear on those questions principles of natural law, virtue ethics, and the teaching of the Catholic Church, and seeks to develop the implications of that teaching for emerging fields of practice.

The Centre engages in scholarly dialogue with academics and practitioners of other traditions. It contributes to public policy debates as well as to debates and consultations within the Church. It runs educational programmes for, and gives advice to, Catholics and other interested healthcare professionals and biomedical scientists.

### 3 Trees Peace

Have you ever noticed the three trees outside Corpus Christi Church and School grounds? If you look on the left-hand side as you drive into the grounds of the Church and school there are three trees. Nothing extraordinary to the untrained eye. But these three trees are part of the rich post war heritage of Coventry City, a City of Peace and Reconciliation.

The trees are laid out in a triangular form; One tree is a Hazel tree, the second is a Maple tree and the third is a Holly tree. Each tree represents one of Coventry's famous three spires which survived intact during the heavy bombing of the Blitz during the Second World War.

Today, those three spires have become powerful global symbol of Peace and Reconciliation. To this end, the Peace Trail, consisting of 18 locations is a gift to the world from the people of Coventry.

Ernesford and Willenhall Ward are twined with the city of Graz in Austria.
