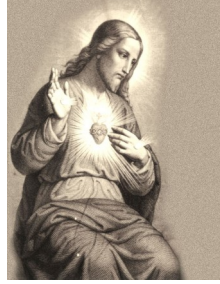
### Friday Benediction for the Month of June

*The priest puts on the Humeral Veil; the people are then blessed with the Blessed Sacrament as the bell is rung thrice.  
All bow in adoration. After Benediction we pray The Divine Praises repeating each praise after the priest.  
Then we sing together three times:*

**O Sacrament Most Holy, O Sacrament Divine,  
all praise and all thanksgiving be every moment thine.**
