NATIONAL MASS OF THANKSGIVING & RENEWAL FOR PRIESTS Priests from across the country, including priests of the Ordinariate, will gather in Westminster Cathedral this Friday, the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, for a Mass of Thanksgiving and Renewal for Priests. The Mass will be celebrated at 12noon by the Cardinal Archbishop of Westminster, Vincent Nichols. The Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus is set aside by the Church as a day of prayer and intercession for the sanctification of priests. Father Tim and Father Paul will be present, and with other ordinariate priests will be enjoying a spot of lunch later with the Ordinary!
