## 16th June 2019: The Most Holy Trinity Yr. C Parish Mass Book - Readings on page 30

### Most Holy Trinity



On the feast of the Blessed Holy Trinity we read from the gospel of John 16:12-15. Some modern readers of the New Testament are often surprised that the word 'Trinity' does not appear in the Bible at all, not in the NT and certainly not in the OT. The term 'Trinity' is a Latin-based word from *trinitas*, meaning the number three or triple. It is a term that Christian theologians in the patristic era, coined to talk about God, and the relationship of the Father, Son, and Spirit. So, though the NT has many texts that speak of God the Father, the Son, and the Spirit, it never refers to them as Trinity. This chapter of John is one such where Jesus the Son makes a reference to the Spirit of truth and to the Father and has been used over the centuries by the church fathers to develop the theology of the Trinity. The doctrine of the Trinity is sophisticated, subtle, and worthy of reflection. There is a dynamic relationship between the three 'persons' of the Trinity that is expressed in a variety of ways in different scriptural passages. In today's passage, Jesus speaks of the Spirit of truth (*other than Holy Spirit*) that has specific role of guiding the disciples to the truth spoken by the Father to glorify the Son. He takes from the Son, who has everything the Father has, and declares it to the disciples. Therefore, within God there is a relationship among Father, Son, and Holy Spirit that can be a complete outpouring from one to the other. We, who have been created in the image and likeness of God, are invited into this community of complete gift of self. In emptying ourselves, we are filled with the love of Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
