Opposite you will find the end of year accounts for 2018 for both parishes. Firstly, we would like to say thank you to all who support Corpus Christi and St. Anne's. Secondly, we would like to thank our committed Joint Finance Team.

2018 was a very special year for both parishes. St. Anne's church celebrated its 40th Anniversary and Corpus Christi church celebrated its 60th Anniversary.

A lot of investment was made into St. Anne's church during the build up to the 40th Anniversary and a number of key maintenance issues that were highlighted in the Quinquennial report were addressed. Those visiting St. Anne's church for the first time and those returning after many years away were deeply impressed by the transformation of the church. Many commented and still do upon it's presentation which is due to the committed and generous members of the parish. Thank you!

Over the last 8 years Corpus Christi church has seen a number of changes and improvements. When the Quinquennial report was produced for Corpus Christi there were no major issues.

2018 was the 60th Anniversary of the Parish Church, but for its celebration the parishioners are pursuing a development of a community hall on the grounds along side the sacristy and Fr. Tuite room.

A Feasibility Report was produced through money gratefully received from a Grant "Awards for All" The parish will have to pay for the upcoming costs of things like Planning Application, Development Designs, Surveys and Consultation Fees which are likely to run into costs of £20k or more so money is being saved.

While all these things and more are or have been happening in our parishes, the normal day-to-day running costs and levies made on our parishes continue to come in as well. It cannot be stressed enough therefore, the great advantage to our parishes of the importance of Gift Aid.

Gift Aid for 2018 for Corpus Christi was £9,212.00 and for St. Anne's £5,252.00. This was money the parishes received, nearly £15k! and it didn't cost a parishioner an extra penny.

Gift Aid is that very simple way of increasing your Offering by 25% without costing you anything. Those who pay Income Tax can inform the Tax Office via the parish that you would like the Church to claim back this money on your behalf for the church's mission and development. Would you turn down a free £15,000? No, of course you wouldn't. Anyone reading this who pays Income Tax and is not still a Gift Aider then we ask you seriously to consider joining the scheme. Please ask about it. It costs you nothing. To good to be true? Well, it is TRUE!!!!!!
