A NEW HOME

At the end of September the Coventry Ordinariate Mission will bid farewell to the parish and people of St Joseph the Worker and make a new home in the church of The Precious Blood and All Souls in the parish of Earlsdon, where Father Paul will be Parish Priest. Our final Sunday at St. Joseph's will be Sunday 22nd September and our first Sunday at All Souls Sunday 29th September. There will be an opportunity for our two communities – of St. Joseph's and the ordinariate – to come together for a 'farewell' Mass and gathering – more details to follow.
