Following the meeting with APEC and Fr. David on Friday 16th August, APEC will now explore an additional design option with a smaller brief, keeping the existing sacristy building.

Once we are happy with the plan, then APEC will start a sketch development of the external design for presentation to the Parish and the Diocesan Art and Architect Committee for early input with a sketch 3D visual and elevation drawings.

APEC also recommend engaging a cost consultant to produce an indicative cost plan based on the conceptual plan to provide a more realistic idea of what the construction cost would be at this early stage.
