Gospel Acclamation: **Glory and praise to you, O Christ! I will leave this place and go to my father and say: 'Father, I have sinned against heaven and against you.' Glory and praise to you, O Christ!**

Gospel: Luke 15:1-3. 11-32  
*Your brother here was dead and has come to life.*

Communion Antiphon: **You must rejoice, my son, for your brother was dead and has come to life; he was lost and is found.**

**Monday, 9<sup>th</sup> March**

**Weekday of Lent**

**Comm. of St Frances of Rome**

Entrance Antiphon: **Redeem me, O Lord, and have mercy on me. My foot stands on level ground; I will bless the Lord in the assembly.**

First Reading: Daniel 9:4-10  
*We have sinned, we have done wrong.*

Responsorial Psalm: **Do not treat us according to our sins, O Lord.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Praise and honour to you, Lord Jesus! The seed is the word of God, Christ the sower, whoever finds this seed will remain for ever. Praise and honour to you, Lord Jesus!**

Gospel: Luke 6:36-38  
*Grant pardon, and you will be pardoned.*

Communion Antiphon: **Be merciful, as your Father is merciful, says the Lord.**

**Tuesday, 10<sup>th</sup> March**

**Weekday of Lent**

Entrance Antiphon: **Give light to my eyes lest I fall asleep in death, lest my enemies say: I have overcome him.**

First Reading: Isaiah 1:10. 16-20

*Learn to do good, search for justice.*

Responsorial Psalm: **I will show God's salvation to the upright.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Glory and praise to you, O Christ! Repent, says the Lord, for the kingdom of heaven is close at hand. Glory and praise to you, O Christ!**

Gospel: Matthew 23:1-12

*They do not practise what they preach.*

Communion Antiphon: **I will recount all your wonders. I will rejoice in you and be glad, and sing psalms to your name, O Most High.**

**Wednesday, 11<sup>th</sup> March**

**Weekday of Lent**

Entrance Antiphon: **Forsake me not, O Lord! My God, be not far from me! Make haste and come to my help, O Lord, my strong salvation!**

First Reading: Jeremiah 18:18-20

*Come on, let us hit at him.*

Responsorial Psalm: **Save me in your love, O Lord.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Glory to you, O Christ, you are the Word of God! Your words are spirit, Lord, and they are life; you have the message of eternal life. Glory to you, O Christ, you are the Word of God!**

Gospel: Matthew 20:17-28

*They will condemn him to death.*

Communion Antiphon: **The Son of Man did not come to be served but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many.**

**Thursday, 12<sup>th</sup> March**

**Weekday of Lent**

Entrance Antiphon: **Test me, O God, and know my thoughts. See that my path is not wicked, and lead me in the way everlasting.**

First Reading: Jeremiah 17:5-10

*A curse on the man who puts his trust in man, a blessing on the man who puts his trust in the Lord.*

Responsorial Psalm: **Happy the man who has placed his trust in the Lord.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Praise to you, O Christ, king of eternal glory! I will leave this place and go to my father and say: 'Father, I have sinned against heaven and against you.' Praise to you, O Christ, king of eternal glory!**

Gospel: Luke 16:19-31

*Good things came your way, just as bad things came the way of Lazarus. Now he is being comforted here while you are in agony.*

Communion Antiphon: **Blessed are those whose way is blameless, who walk in the law of the Lord.**

**Friday, 13<sup>th</sup> March**

**Weekday of Lent**

Gospel Acclamation: **Praise and honour to your, Lord Jesus! God loved the world so much that he gave his only Son; everyone who believes in him has eternal life. Praise and honour to you, Lord Jesus!**

Gospel: Matthew 21:33-43. 45-46

*This is the heir. Come on, let us kill him.*
