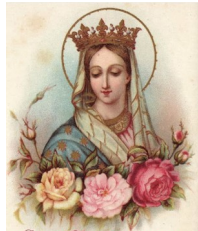

Increase in Parish Levies

For a couple of weeks parishioners were notified that there would be an increase in Parish Levies. We explained at great length what a Levy was, why they are taken and what they are used for within the Archdiocese of Birmingham.

The Levies are taken quarterly, directly from every Parish Bank Account within the Archdiocese.

What that means in reality is that for;

- Corpus Christi the Levy will rise quarterly from £2,135.90 to £4,567.99. A yearly increase of £9,728.36
- St. Anne's the Levy will rise quarterly from £1,136.69 to £3,653.58. A yearly increase of £10,067.56!
