Thanks for supporting the Blessing of the Bibles and I hope it will be an encouragement to read the Bible more regularly. We will be arranging some Deanery Talks for Lent and Advent 2020, which will be hosted by parishes around the city with a variety of speakers. We will be producing a poster over the next few weeks and the topics will all be related to the Holy Bible. This might be something to help you through Lent and Advent.

As you know we have a very thriving youth ministry in the parish, with a Youth Group and a Youth Café Group. We are looking to recruit some new leaders. You have to be over 18 years. We will give you full training and arrange Safeguarding checks. It is a great thing to get involved in and will give opportunities to be involved in Lourdes Pilgrimages and World Youth Day events. It will be a very useful experience for anyone thinking of a career in Teaching or Youth and Social work. The Youth Groups meet on Tuesday evenings in term time. Why not give it a go!!

Thanks so much for your continued support of various charities such as the Night Shelter, the Foodbank and Global Care to name just a few. We sent off £7,000 to CAFOD for the Cyclone Appeal as well as £4,000 for the two Family Fast Appeals. We have also given nearly £4,000 to the Saint Vincent de Paul Society for their work among the needy in our own city. This included an anonymous donation of £1,000.
