Light and Healing

"Your light must shine before people, so that they will see the good things you do and praise your Father in heaven"
(Matthew 5:10)

Light is the key word that we find in the first and gospel reading of this Sunday. In the second reading Paul, from his own experience, enlightens us that real light does not come from 'wise' reasoning and clever sophistry but from the cross of Jesus. The light which comes from the cross and shines in our lives should lead us to those people among us who are 'hungry', 'afflicted' and 'homeless', in order to be in the presence of 'Jesus Christ and Him crucified', who came as light to dispel darkness.

We Christians are to be instruments of peace, warmth, love, trust, confidence, respect, dignity, care and concern. When we were baptised, a candle was placed in our hand while the ministering priest pronounced these meaningful words: "Receive this burning and keep the grace of your baptism through a blameless life...." By baptism we are made children of God who is light and source of light. As children of the Father of light, we can bring glory to our Father only by being children of the light, bearers of light.

Light and healing are within us. When we, as Christians, share our light in the witness of our lives, that witness can puzzle people into wonder. It is possible to share our light even without speaking a single word, just by our personal life and actions.
