Weekday in Easter

Entrance Antiphon: **O chosen people, proclaim the mighty works of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light, alleluia.**

First Reading: Acts 13:44-52  
*We must turn to the pagans.*

Responsorial Psalm: **All the ends of the earth have seen the salvation of our God.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! Christ, having been raised from the dead will never die again. Death has no power over him anymore. Alleluia!**

Gospel: John 14:7-14  
*To have seen me is to have seen the Father.*

Communion Antiphon: **Father, I wish that, where I am, those you gave me may also be with me, that they may see the glory that you gave me, alleluia.**





Monday, 4<sup>th</sup> May

THE ENGLISH MARTYRS



*Today we celebrate the English men and women martyred for the Catholic faith between 1535 and 1680, which have been beatified or canonised by the Holy See.*

Entrance Antiphon: **These who are clothed in white robes are they who have survived the time of great distress and have washed their robes in the blood of the Lamb, alleluia.**

The **Gloria** is said.

First Reading: Acts 7:55-60  
*Lord Jesus, receive my spirit.*

Responsorial Psalm: **Into your hand, O Lord, I commend my spirit.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! We praise you, O God, we acknowledge you to be the Lord; the noble army of martyrs praise you, O Lord. Alleluia!**

Gospel: Matthew 10:17-20  
*You will be dragged before governors and kings for my sake, to bear witness before them and the pagans.*

Communion Antiphon: **To the victor I will give the right to eat from the tree of life, which is in the paradise of my God, alleluia.**

**Tuesday, 5th May**

**Weekday of Easter**

Entrance Antiphon: **Let us rejoice and be glad and give glory to God, for the Lord our God the Almighty reigns, alleluia.**

First Reading: Acts 11:19-26

*They started preaching to the Greeks, proclaiming the Lord Jesus.*

Responsorial Psalm: **O praise the Lord, all you nations!**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! The sheep that belong to me listen to my voice, says the Lord; I know them and they follow me. Alleluia!**

Gospel: John 10:22-30

*The Father and I are one.*

Communion Antiphon: **The Christ had to suffer and rise from the dead, and so enter into his glory, alleluia.**

**Wednesday, 6th May**

**Weekday of Easter**

Entrance Antiphon: **I will praise you, Lord, among the nations; I will tell of your name to my kin, alleluia.**

First Reading: Acts 12:24 – 13:5

*Set Barnabas and Saul apart.*

Responsorial Psalm: **Let the peoples praise you, O God; let all the peoples praise you.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! You believe, Thomas, because you can see me. Happy are those who have not seen and yet believe. Alleluia!**

Gospel: John 12:44-50

*I, the light, have come into the world.*

Communion Antiphon: **I have chosen you from the world, says the Lord, and have appointed you to go out and bear fruit, fruit that will last, alleluia.**

**Thursday, 7th May**

**Weekday of Easter**

Entrance Antiphon: **O God, when you went forth before your people, marching with them and living among them, the earth trembled, heavens poured down rain. alleluia.**

First Reading: Acts 13:13-25

*God has raised up one of David's descendants, Jesus, as Saviour.*

Responsorial Psalm: **I will sing forever of your love, O Lord.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! You O Christ, are the faithful witness, the first-born from the dead; you have loved us and have washed away our sins with your blood. Alleluia!**

Gospel: John 13:16-20

*Whoever welcomes the one I send welcomes me.*

Communion Antiphon: **Behold, I am with you always, even to the end of the age, alleluia.**

**Friday, 8th May**

Entrance Antiphon: **You have redeemed us, Lord, by your Blood, from every tribe and tongue and people and nation, and have made us into a kingdom, priests for our God, alleluia.**

First Reading: Acts 13:26-33

*God has fulfilled his promise by raising Jesus from the dead.*

Responsorial Psalm: **You are my Son. It is I who have begotten you this day.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! Since you have been brought back to true life with Christ, you must look for the things that are in heaven where Christ is, sitting at God's right hand. Alleluia!**

Gospel: John 14:1-6

*I am the Way, the Truth and the Life.*

Communion Antiphon: **Christ our Lord was handed over for our transgressions and was raised again for our justification, alleluia.**
