

Communion Antiphon: **You are the temple of God, and God's spirit dwells in you. The temple of God is holy. You are that temple.**

Entrance Antiphon: **Christ loved us and washed us clean of our sins by his Blood, and made us into a kingdom, priests for his God and Father, alleluia.**

First Reading: Acts 25 13-21
Said to be dying, and here we are alive.

Responsorial Psalm: **Our life, like a bird has escaped from the snare of the fowler.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! Blessed be God, a gentle Father, and the God of all consolation, who comforts us in our sorrows. Alleluia!**

Gospel: John 21:15-19
Feed my lambs, feed my sheep.

Communion Antiphon: **When the spirit of truth comes, he will teach you all truth, says the Lord, alleluia.**

Saturday, 30th May

Weekday in Easter

Entrance Antiphon: **The disciples devoted themselves with one accord to prayer with the women, and Mary the Mother of Jesus, and his brethren, alleluia.**

First Reading: Acts 28:16-20. 30-31
Paul stayed in Rome, proclaiming the kingdom of God.

Responsorial Psalm: **The upright shall see your face, O Lord.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! Since you have been brought back to true life with Christ, you must look for the things that are in heaven where Christ is sitting at God's right hand. Alleluia!**

Gospel: John 21:20-25
This disciple is the one who has written these things down, and we know that his testimony is true.

Communion Antiphon: **The Holy Spirit will glorify me, for he will take from what is mine and declare it to you, says the Lord, alleluia.**

Monday, 25th May

**St Bede the Venerable, Priest
and Doctor of the Church**

Bede died in 573, a monk of Jarrow. He was a great scholar and wrote the Ecclesiastical History of the English People, gaining him the title 'The Father of English History'. He is patron of English writers and historians. Bede was declared a Doctor of the Church in 1899 by Pope Leo XIII

Entrance Antiphon: **In the midst of the Church he opened his mouth, and the Lord filled him with the spirit of wisdom and understanding and clothed him in a robe of glory, alleluia.**

First Reading: Acts 19:1-8
Did you receive the Holy Spirit when you became believers?

Responsorial Psalm: **Kingdoms of the earth, sing to God.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! I came from the Father and have come into the world, and now I leave the world to go to the Father. Alleluia!**

Gospel: John 16:29-33
Be brave: I have conquered the world.

Communion Antiphon: **Behold a faithful and prudent steward to give them their allowance of food at the proper time, alleluia.**

Tuesday, 26th May

St Philip Neri, Priest

Philip died in 1559. Having undergone a profound conversion he became a priest in Rome. He founded the Congregation of the Oratory and had a great love for all people, no matter their status in life.

Entrance Antiphon: **The love of God has been poured into our hearts through the Spirit of God dwelling within us, alleluia.**

First Reading: Acts 20:17-27
I am finishing my race and carrying out the mission the Lord Jesus gave me.

Responsorial Psalm: **Kingdoms of the earth, sing to God.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! I will not leave you orphans, says the Lord; I go, but I will come back to you, and your hearts will be full of joy. Alleluia!**

Gospel: John 17:1-11
Father, glorify your Son.

Communion Antiphon: **As the Father loves me, so I also love you; remain in my love, alleluia.**

Wednesday, 27th May

ST AUGUSTINE OF CANTERBURY, BISHOP

Augustine was sent by Pope Gregory the Great to establish the Faith in England. Though previous missionaries had evangelised in England, notably the Celtic saints, it was Augustine who has become known as the Apostle of England. He was the first Archbishop of Canterbury. He died in 605. In 2010 this celebration was raised to the rank of Feast.

Entrance Antiphon: **I will praise you, Lord, among the nations; I will tell of your name to my kin, alleluia.**

The **Gloria** is said.

First Reading: 1 Thessalonians 2:2-8
We were eager to hand over not only the Good News but our whole lives as well.

Responsorial Psalm: **Go out to the whole world; proclaim the Good News.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! The Lord has sent me to bring the good news to the poor, to proclaim liberty to captives. Alleluia!**

Gospel: Luke 10:1-9
The harvest is rich but the labourers are few.

Communion Antiphon: **O chosen people, proclaim the mighty works of him who called you out of darkness, into his wonderful light, alleluia.**

Thursday, 28th May

Weekday in Easter

Entrance Antiphon: **With boldness let us approach the throne of grace, they we may receive mercy and find grace as a timely help, alleluia.**

First Reading: Acts 22:30; 23:6-11
Now you must bear witness in Rome.

Responsorial Psalm: **Preserve me, Lord, I take refuge in you.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! I will send you the Spirit of truth, says the Lord; he will lead you to the complete truth. Alleluia!**

Gospel: John 17:20-26
May they be completely one.

Communion Antiphon: **I tell you the truth, it is for your good that I go; for if I do not go away, the Paraclete will not come to you, says the Lord, alleluia.**

Friday, 29th May

SOLEMNITY OF THE DEDICATION

Entrance Antiphon: **Wonderful are you, O God in your holy place. The God of Israel himself gives his people strength and courage. Blessed be God!**

The **Gloria** is said.

First Reading: Apocalypse 21:1-5
Here God lives among men.

Responsorial Psalm: **How lovely is your dwelling place, Lord, God of hosts.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! I shall make my home among them, says the Lord; I will be their God, they shall be my people, Alleluia!**

Gospel: 4:19-24
True worshippers will worship the Father in spirit and truth.

The **CREED** is said.
