The Gospel is proper to this memorial.

First Reading: 2 Chronicles 24:17-25
You murdered Zechariah between the sanctuary and the altar.

Responsorial Psalm: **My heart exults in the Lord, my Saviour.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! Blessed is the virgin Mary who treasured the word of God, and pondered it in her heart. Alleluia!**

Gospel: Luke: 2:41-51
See how worried your father and I have been, looking for you.

Communion Antiphon: **Mary treasured these things in her heart.**

Entrance Antiphon: **O Lord, hear my voice, for I have called to you; be my help. Do not abandon or forsake me, O God, my Saviour!**

First Reading: 1 Kings 21:1-16
Naboth has been stoned to death.

Responsorial Psalm: **Give heed to my groaning, O Lord.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! If anyone loves me he will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and we shall come to him. Alleluia!**

Gospel: Matthew 5:38-42
I say this to you: offer the wicked man no resistance.

Communion Antiphon: **There is one thing I ask of the Lord, only this do I seek: to live in the house of the Lord all the days of my life.**

Tuesday, 16th June

**Weekday or
St Richard of Chichester, Bishop**

Richard was born in Droitwich, Worcestershire c.1197 and was appointed Bishop of Chichester in 1244 against the wishes of the monarch, Henry III. He was both hardworking and charitable. He is said to have dropped the chalice while celebrating Mass which miraculously remained unspilled. In art he is often depicted with a chalice at his feet.

Entrance Antiphon: **O Lord, hear my voice, for I have called to you; be my help. Do not abandon or forsake me, O God, my Saviour!**

First Reading: 1 Kings 21:17-29
You led Israel into sin.

Responsorial Psalm: **Have mercy on us, Lord, for we have sinned.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! God in Christ was reconciling the world to himself, and he has entrusted to us the news that they are reconciled. Alleluia!**

Gospel: Matthew 5:43-48
Love your enemies.

Communion Antiphon: **There is one thing I ask of the Lord, only this do I seek: to live in the house of the Lord all the days of my life.**

Wednesday, 17th June

Entrance Antiphon: **O Lord, hear my voice, for I have called to you; be my help. Do not abandon or forsake me, O God, my Saviour!**

First Reading: 2 Kings 2:1. 6-14
A chariot of fire appeared and Elijah went up to heaven.

Responsorial Psalm: **Let your heart take courage, all who hope in the Lord.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! Let the message of Christ, in all its richness, find a home with you; through him give thanks to God the Father. Alleluia!**

Gospel: Matthew 6:1-6. 16-18
Your Father who sees all that is done in secret will reward you.

Communion Antiphon: **There is one thing I ask of the Lord, only this do I seek: to live in the house of the Lord all the days of my life.**

Thursday, 18th June

DEDICATION OF ST CHAD'S CATHEDRAL



The Mother church of the Diocese was designed by AW Pugin. It was the first Catholic cathedral to be built in England since the reformation. It was opened on 21 June 1841. It became a metropolitan cathedral in 1911 and a minor basilica in 1941.

Entrance Antiphon: **I saw the holy city, the new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, as beautiful as a bride adorned for her husband.**

The **Gloria** is said.

First Reading: 1 Kings 8:22-23. 27-30
Let your eyes watch over this house.

Alt: Corinthians 3:9-11, 16-17.
You are the temple of God.

Responsorial Psalm: **I long to live in the house of the Lord.**

Gospel Acclamation: **Alleluia, alleluia! You are Peter and on this rock I will build my Church, and the gates of the underworld can never hold out against it. Alleluia!**

Gospel: Matthew 16:13-19
You are Peter. I will give you the keys of the Kingdom of Heaven.

Communion Antiphon: **May you, the holy priesthood that offers spiritual sacrifices which Jesus Christ has made visible to God, become the living stones making a spiritual house.**

Friday, 19th June

THE MOST SACRED HEART OF JESUS

Entrance Antiphon: **The designs of his Heart are from age to age, to rescue their souls from death, and to keep them alive in famine.**

The **Gloria** is said.

First Reading: Deuteronomy 7:6-11 (LI-p628)
The Lord set his heart on you, and chose you.

Responsorial Psalm: **The love of the Lord is everlasting upon those he has chosen in fear.**

Second Reading: John 4:7-16
Love comes from God.
