2020 is the '**Year of The Word**', a year marked by three themes, **CELEBRATING**, **LIVING** and **SHARING**. In both parishes there are even more young people who are preparing to celebrate the Sacraments, so that they can live a life more focused on Christ and so share in his mission.

After half-term, beginning of the weekend of 7th and 8th March Fr. David will be inviting those children who are preparing for the Sacraments in 2021 to participate in the Bidding prayers.

The Angelus and The Prayer for England

The Angelus is the prayer commemorating the Incarnation and is traditionally said three times a day, around 6am, Noon and 6pm.

The Prayer for England, is a prayer asking Our Lady's intercession to return England, the Dowry of Mary to the one true fold united under the Vicar of Christ, the successor of St. Peter.

There is a prayer card at the back of Church with these two prayers on them. We encourage you to take one home and recite these prayers often, especially during these 33 days in preparation to celebrate the Annunciation on 25th March and the re-dedication of England as Mary's Dowry on Sunday 29th March.

Our Lady of Walsingham

From the 22nd February until 25th March there are 33 days. These 33 days have been given to us to prepare not only for the Feast of the Annunciation but also for the personal rededication of England as the Dowry of Mary.

It was in Walsingham that a copy of the holy house of Nazareth was built in the 11th century. Walsingham was a special place of pilgrimage for Monarchs and ordinary people. It was numbered among the great shrines throughout Christendom, but was sadly destroyed under the order of Henry VIII in the 16th century.

After years of prayer, martyrdom and hope, England will once again be known as *Mary's Dowry*.

We will have a special Mass on Wednesday 25th March at 7pm in Corpus Christi and a Holy Hour on Sunday 29th March at 4pm in St. Anne's to mark this wonderful occasion.
