He is risen indeed, Alleluia!



	<p>First reading Acts 10: 34, 37-43 This is the apostle Peter's first speech before an audience of Gentiles. Peter has only recently become convinced that the Gentiles are even part of God's plan. He summarizes the whole gospel for them.</p>	<p>Second reading Colossians 3: 1-4 Saint Paul often writes about how Christ should influence our behaviour. This passage is about how our thoughts should change, as a result of the resurrection of Jesus.</p>	<p>Gospel John 20:1-9 This resurrection scene from St. John's gospel emphasises the empty tomb, not the appearance of Jesus, as a cause for faith. There is not, as we might expect, the boundless joy of the disciples seeing Jesus alive again. Instead, we are encouraged to spend time with his followers in their longing, anxiety, sadness, and utter confusion. St. John wants us to see that the followers of Jesus were slow to understand what he had told them many times: that he would rise from the dead.</p>
