


13th May - The Feast of Our Lady of Fatima

It was on the 13th day of May in 1917 that the Blessed Virgin Mary started her series of apparition to three shepherd children in the small village of Fatima in Portugal. She appeared six times to Lucia, who was then 9 years of age, and her cousins Francisco, who was 8 at that time, and his sister Jacinta, aged 6, every 13th of the month between the months of May and October.

The Blessed Mother came to the little village of Fatima which had remained faithful to the Catholic Church during the recent oppressions by the government. Our Lady came with a message from God to all. She promised that the whole world would be in peace, and that many souls would go to Heaven if her requests were listened to and obeyed. She requested all followers of her Son Jesus for prayers for peace in Russia and the whole world. She requested for reparation and conversion of hearts.

And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back again and take you to myself, so that where I am you also may be.


Where I am going you know the way."
