Church Offerings

Like so many other charities the Church relies on the generosity of her members. At the moment because of the coronavirus many charities are going without, including our parishes. We are well aware of the difficulties also on families at this time. So, if you are able and would like to pay using Standing Order to either St. Anne's' or Corpus Christi then please drop Fr. David an email for further information. Another option is to go onto the home page of the diocesan website - www.birminghamdiocese.org.uk and click on a donate button (top right). From these donations which can also be gift aided can be made to any parish via credit or debit card. Funds will initially be passed to the diocese but we will have reports available to allow us to pass them on to each parish, we will work the process out over the next week or 2 and much will depend on how much it is used. There are transaction charges levied by the card processing company so please do note therefore that standing order remains the most cost effective way for parishioners to donate. Another further option could be is to save your offerings until we meet again. Thank you for your continual support.

Coronavirus and churches

At present, opening churches has not been agreed by the Government, so churches must continue to remain closed at present. We are all aware that we are facing an unprecedented situation. We have not faced re-opening churches in the face of a pandemic in living memory. Best practice and compliance with guidelines are our Christian and civic duty and responsibility. I thank you for your ongoing compliance on behalf of all those who will thereby avoid suffering as a result of our sacrifices. However, it is now timely to make preparations in anticipation of that permission being given at some point.

In order to re-open our Churches we will need to ensure that we have adequate volunteers to support the process of stewarding and cleaning the church after each day of use. If there are not sufficient volunteers to clean the church after each use then the church cannot be opened. We have a duty of care to all who use our churches for prayer and worship. Members of our cleaning and stewarding teams should be deemed healthy and fit for work prior to commencement of work. At present this excludes those who are deemed vulnerable (over 70 years, and/or with certain pre-existing health conditions, self-isolating or shielding). This may change. So, younger and fitter members of our parishes will have to help when the time arises.

I thank you for your ongoing compliance with guidelines. Compliance is the only way of ensuring we are safe and are seen


No access to the Internet? Why not ask your friends or fellow parishioners if they have access to the Internet. If they don't, you could offer to print off the Newsletter for them.
