"ALL THESE JOINED IN CONTINUOUS PRAYER"

Most often, we hear people asking for prayers from their pastors, friends and relations. It has become part and parcel of our way of wishing each other well, by saying I will pray for you or you pray for me. These expressions underpin our dependence on God and our support for each other in life's journey, especially when we face crisis. Among all other prayers, what is so edifying and unifying is the prayer Lord Jesus raises to the Father in today's Gospel when he said, *I am not praying for the world but for those you have given me, because they belong to you: all I have is yours and all you have is mine.* This indicates perfect unity and cooperation between Father and Son, which all of us believers should endeayour to emulate.

Today we celebrate the 7th Sunday of Easter. It occurs between the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord and Pentecost. It is within the period of waiting for the coming of the Holy Spirit in prayer. In the first reading from the Acts of Apostles, it is mentioned that the apostles went back from the Mount of Olives and stayed in the upper room in continuous prayer together with Mary mother of the Lord. The apostles were in great difficulty because of all that had transpired with their master. After the resurrection He appeared to many of them on several occasions. This was to encourage them. Their worries again trickled back, when he ascended into heaven. At the same time, they recalled the assurance of an Advocate whom the Lord had promised, so they remained while waiting in continuous prayer. As Christians today, we need to renew our faith in the power of the Holy Spirit who guides, sanctifies and strengthens the Church. At this time when we are broken in thoughts due to untold difficulties caused by the Covid-19 pandemic. We need to trust in the Lord's promises to calm our spiritual and psychological or emotional difficulties. We are called to keep praying and supporting or encouraging each other like the first disciples of the Lord. Our Christian unity and love are expressed in prayer when we call God, "Our Father" in the Lord's prayer.
