VOLUNTEERS REQUIRED: Although we have had no confirmation of dates or how this will happen at present, we have been asked to prepare the Churches for re-opening, by asking for volunteers. There will be strict guidelines in accordance with the directives from the Government and the Bishop's Conference and at present it looks like it will be limited to **PRIVATE PRAYER** only (Masses will continue to be streamed), as stated this has not been arranged yet, but we will require at least 12 volunteers from each Parish to help us once we are given permission to open. These will be stewards and cleaners. All volunteers should be in good health, currently this excludes those who are deemed vulnerable (over 70 years, and/or with certain pre-existing health conditions, self-isolating or shielding). This may change. All socially distancing will be expected and PPE will be provided. OLA will also be looking for some volunteers to tidy the outside in readiness. If you can spare a couple of hours a week and would like to volunteer please contact the relevant Parish Secretary with your details. If we do not get enough volunteers it will not be possible to open either Church.
