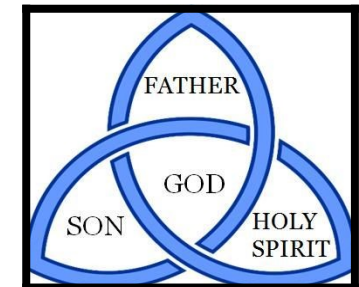
Parish Newsletter – Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity June 2020

THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

“In the Name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.”

Religious belief is the main channel through which human beings search for the meaning of life. It is the natural tendency towards the Author and Source of life. Different religious traditions have basic articles of faith that keep them together as they search for the answers to the most posed questions of life like, the meaning of life, suffering, mortality, and eternity. Whilst in Christian belief, Jesus Christ gives complete answers to these baffling questions of human life. He said, “Yes, God so loved the world that He gave His only Son that whoever believes in him may not perish but may have eternal life” (Jn3:16). The life and the Gospel of Jesus Christ are about the Heavenly Kingdom, which reveal the presence and love God in the world. Christian belief holds that God is One, but three Persons as revealed by the life and the mission of Jesus Christ.

Today, we celebrate the Most Holy Trinity Sunday. The Church's teaching is “the mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the central mystery of Christian faith and of Christian life. God alone can make it known to us by revealing Himself as the Father, Son and the Holy Spirit” (CC.261). God is One, but He reveals Himself to us as the Father the Creator, the Son the Redeemer, and the Holy Spirit the Sanctifier. The same nature but three Persons. On the day of commissioning the disciples Jesus said, “Go therefore, and make disciples from all nations. Baptise them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit and teach them to fulfil all that I have commanded you” (Matt28:19). Following the history of our salvation, God revealed Himself as Trinity. At the Incarnation, the Baptism of the Lord and at the Transfiguration on Mount Tabor the presence of Holy Trinity was manifested. During the Passion, Crucifixion, Death and at the Resurrection of Jesus was in Spiritual union with the Father. The Holy Trinity works in Unity of Three Persons. As believers in God we should promote unity, love, peace, respect, teamwork and care for the needy. We should avoid individualism and a lukewarm attitude in families and communities.
