

Church Offerings

As we return back to church from the 4th July, things in the church and the way we do things will have to change for the time being.

Regarding Church offerings: like all charities, the Church relies on your support. Those parishioners attending Mass on the weekends will be asked to give their Offering before Mass. We cannot pass the leather bags around as before. So, as you enter the Church of Corpus Christi or St. Anne's there will be a wooden box marked clearly "**CHURCH OFFERINGS**" please place your offering into the Wooden Box before Mass.

At the end of Mass, as you leave the church, there will be a Church Warden standing at the doors with a BASKET. This Collection is for the PARISH DEVELOPMENT FUND.

Those of you attending Mass during the week need not worry, we will have a similar system for you.

This will be the norm for the time being. So to repeat, Please place your First offering in the WOODEN BOX marked CHURCH OFFERINGS before Mass, and place your offering for PARISH DEVELOPMENT in the basket as you leave. Remember the best way to help your Parish is by setting up a Direct Debit, it is easy. It is easier for you and easier for our counters and office staff. Thank you for your support and understanding.

The Coronavirus and Churches

The Government has said that churches may open for Public Mass as of 4th July. This information is a warm welcome and a small sign of things returning to some kind of normality.

Regarding the return to the Public Celebration of Mass:

There are a number of important instructions that we must follow. It is not, I'm afraid *business as usually*. Just as we have had to get used to a different way of shopping, so we will have to get used to a different way of Spiritual Living.

The Church Guidelines and regulations are about Common Sense. Individuals have to take responsibility for their own actions. Your own actions may cause harm to others; every action has a consequence, so,

STAY ALERT! PROTECT ONE ANOTHER! JESUS SAVES!

The Sunday Obligation to attend Mass is still suspended. You are not obligated to attend Mass for Sunday (or the Vigil Saturday evening Mass) at this current time. Therefore, in order to ensure everyone has an opportunity to come to Mass we would strongly encourage those parishioners who do not work Tuesday to Friday to attend a weekday Mass instead and leave the weekend Masses freer for those who do have to work Monday to Friday. An extra Mass may be needed on the weekend, but the same rules will apply to that possible extra Mass, i.e. the cleaning and stewarding of the church.

Those who are deemed vulnerable; the over 70's, and/or with certain pre-existing health conditions, those self-isolating or shielding or live with another person who is deemed vulnerable should think about remaining at home or attending a quieter mid-week Mass.

The social distancing will apply in the church especially for seating and movement around the church. There will be stewards to help and guide you. It will be first come, first seated. In order to fit in as many people as possible and safe to do so, we will go down from Two Metres to One Metre Social Distancing. At One Metre Social Distancing **it is Compulsory to wear some sort of face covering**.

We do not want to turn anyone away from the church, so for the first week if you do turn up for Mass without some sort of Face covering you will have to sit in the Two Metre Zone which has limited seating capacity. Next week you will have to have your faces covered with a mask or a scarf. The number of people able to be admitted into the Church for Mass will have to be drastically reduced if we don't have your cooperation. Again, since the Sunday Obligation is suspended, please consider using an alternative Mass time during the week if and when you can.

This is a new experience for all of us, so we ask you for your cooperation, patience and understanding. Somethings we will have to play by ear at first, but it is only by getting out there will we know what works and what doesn't work, One size does not fit all.

To those individuals who will be returning to Mass, please remember the following key points:

- ◆ The Church will have a separate entrance and exit, where possible.
- ◆ It is Compulsory to wear a face covering whilst visiting the church for Mass at One Meter Social Distancing.
- ◆ Please sanitise your hands when entering and leaving the church. Hand gels are available at the entrance and exits of the Church.
- ◆ There will be no Mass/Hymn Books or Missalettes. Newsletters will be available, but must be taken home once touched. Newsletters must not be given out by Church Wardens or Stewards.
- ◆ Please leave a meter distance between each household or Common Households while seated. In Corpus Christi Church, a metre is two chairs. In St. Anne's Church, there is a metre length red and white tape on every pew, please adjust the position of the red and white tape according to your number.
- ◆ Please do not touch the statues. Remember if you have touched something, so may have someone else. The least number of surfaces touched by people the better for yourselves.
- ◆ To request a Mass or Candle Intention(s) please go to the Sacristy to fill out an envelope or form, unless you have arrived with your own envelope or form. Intentions can be posted through the Presbytery door, during the week.
- ◆ There will be a one way system in place for Holy Communion. Please come forward for Holy Communion a row at a time, remembering to leave a metre distance between you and the person in front of you.
- ◆ Sadly, there are no votive candles or Holy Water at this time. Parishioners are not permitted to bring in their own candles. Fr. David, will gladly bless your own bottles of water.
- ◆ The Sacristy, the Fr. Tuite Room, the Joachim Room and all the toilets will be strictly out of bounds to everyone during the public opening of the church.
- ◆ Readers and Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion must sanitise their hands a second time before carrying out their ministry.
- ◆ Confession will be outdoors.

Thank you for your ongoing compliance with guidelines. Compliance is the only way of ensuring we are safe and are seen to be safe, so protecting the vulnerable.
