Church Offerings

Like all charities, the Church relies on the support of others. Last weekend was the first time Mass had been celebrated Publicly in our parish churches. Many of those who attended the Mass and Masses during the week kindly brought in past envelopes and offerings that they have been otherwise unable to give. During the Lockdown others kindly posted their offerings through the Presbytery door and others still continued to give directly through the bank. We'd like to thank you for your support. To those parishioners attending Mass for the first time this weekend since Lockdown can we please ask you to give Offering before Mass. We cannot pass the leather bags around as before. So, as you enter the Church of Corpus Christi or St. Anne's there will be a wooden box marked clearly "**CHURCH OFFERINGS**" please place your offering into the Wooden Box before Mass. At the end of Mass, as you leave the church, there will be a Church Warden standing at the doors with a BASKET. This Collection is for the **PARISH DEVELOPMENT FUND**. Those of you attending Mass during the week need not worry, we will have a similar system for you. This will be the norm for the time being. Remember the best way to help your Parish is by setting up a Direct Debit, it is easy. It is easier for you and easier for our counters and office staff. Thank you for your support and understanding.

The Coronavirus and Churches

Regarding the return to the Public Celebration of Mass: There are a number of important instructions that we must follow. It is not, I'm afraid *business as usually*. Just as we have had to get used to a different way of shopping, so we will have to get used to a different way of Spiritual Living. The Church Guidelines and regulations are about Common Sense. Individuals have to take responsibility for their own actions. Your own actions may cause harm to others; every action has a consequence, so,

STAY ALERT! PROTECT ONE ANOTHER! JESUS SAVES!

The Sunday Obligation to attend Mass is still suspended. You are not obligated to attend Mass for Sunday (*or the Vigil Saturday evening Mass*) at this current time. Therefore, in order to ensure everyone has an opportunity to come to Mass we would suggest that those parishioners who do not work Tuesday to Friday to attend a weekday Mass instead and leave the weekend Masses free for those who do have to work Monday to Friday.

Those who are deemed vulnerable; the over 70's, and/or with certain pre-existing health conditions, those self-isolating or shielding or live with another person who is deemed vulnerable should think about remaining at home or attending a quieter mid-week Mass.

The social distancing will apply in the church especially for seating and movement around the church. There will be stewards to help and guide you. It will be first come, first seated. In order to fit in as many people as possible and safe to do so, we will go down from Two Metres to One Metre Social Distancing.

At One Metre Social Distancing it is Compulsory to wear some sort of face covering.

We do not want to turn anyone away from the church, so if you do turn up for Mass without some sort of Face covering you will have to sit in the Two Metre Zone which has limited seating capacity. By not wearing some sort of Face covering you are reducing the number of people able to be admitted into the Church for Mass. So, please be sensible and generous and come to Mass prepared to cover your face.

This is a new experience for all of us, so we ask you for your cooperation, patience and understanding. Somethings we will probably be able to change as time goes by, but for the meantime that us try and keep everyone safe who come to our Church.

To those individuals who are coming to Mass, please remember the following key points:

- ◆ The Church will have a separate entrance and exit, where possible.
- ◆ It is Compulsory to wear a face covering whilst visiting the church for Mass at One Metre Social Distancing.
- ◆ Please sanitise your hands when entering and leaving the church. Hand gels are available at the entrance and exits of the Church.
- ◆ There will be no Mass/Hymn Books or Missalettes. Newsletters will be available, but must be taken home once touched. Newsletters must not be given out by Church Wardens or Stewards.
- ◆ Please leave a metre distance between each household or Common Households while seated. In Corpus Christi Church, a metre is two chairs. In St. Anne's Church, there is a metre length red and white tape on every pew, please adjust the position of the red and white tape according to your number.
- ◆ Please do not touch the statues. Remember if you have touched something, so may have someone else. The least number of surfaces touched by people the better for yourselves.
- ◆ To request a Mass or Candle Intention(s) please go to the Sacristy to fill out an envelope or form, unless you have arrived with your own envelope or form. Intentions can be posted through the Presbytery door, during the week.
- ◆ There will be a one way system in place for Holy Communion. Please come forward for Holy Communion a row at a time, remembering to leave a metre distance between you and the person in front of you.
- ◆ Sadly, there is no Holy Water at this time. Parishioners are welcome to bring in their bottles of water which Fr. David, will gladly bless.
- ◆ The Fr. Tuite Room, the Joachim Room will not be in operation. If you have to use the toilet, please be prepared to go back in the toilet after Mass to help clean them.
- ◆ Readers and Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion must sanitise their hands a second time before carrying out their ministry.
- ◆ Confession will be outdoors.

The churches can only be open for Public Mass if people are willing to help clean them after Mass. Please be prepared to offer your help and ensure those who come to Mass are safe. Thank you for your ongoing compliance with guidelines. Compliance is the only way of ensuring we are safe and are seen to be safe, so protecting the vulnerable.

To our two primary schools; Governors, Staff and Pupils

All through the Lockdown our schools have remained open and have had to adopt to some difficult circumstances. As our schools come to the end of the academic year on Friday 17th July we wish everyone a well deserved rest.
