### The Coronavirus, Face Coverings and Church

From Saturday 25th July 2020 it will be compulsory for all people in church to wear some sort of face covering.

#### **NO MASK, NO ENTRY**

Granted, face masks are no joy to wear, as I am sure you well know by now and given the choice we would prefer to be free of them. Nevertheless, their practical utility in protecting others and one's self from the virus has been attested by scientific and medical authorities. I am sure that you would agree with me that the public safety of others is a higher good than our own personal comfort

There are of course people who will be exempt from wearing a face covering, these included children under the age of 11; people who cannot put on, wear or remove a face covering without experiencing "severe distress"; individuals with physical or mental disabilities who may have an issue with wearing a face coverings; people who communicate with others through lip-reading; and individuals with breathing conditions will not be required to follow the regulation.

To those individuals who are in the exempt category, by coming to Mass, by being in a public enclosed space you are putting yourself at risk and must accept full responsibility for your actions. If you have underlying health issues maybe for the time being you should remain safe, and stay at home.

**Regarding the return to the Public Celebration of Mass:** The Church Guidelines and regulations are about Common Sense. Individuals have to take responsibility for their own actions. Your own actions may cause harm to others; every action has a consequence, so,

To those individuals who are coming to Mass, please remember the following key points:

- ◆ The Church will have a separate entrance and exit, where possible.
- ◆ It is Compulsory to wear a face covering whilst visiting the church for Mass.
- ◆ Please sanitise your hands when entering and leaving the church. Hand gels are available at the entrance and exits of the Church.
- ◆ There will be no Mass/Hymn Books or Missalettes. Newsletters will be available, but must be taken home once touched. Newsletters must not be given out by Church Wardens or Stewards.
- ◆ Please leave a metre distance between each household or Common Households while seated. In Corpus Christi Church, one metre equals two chairs. In St. Anne's Church, there is a metre length red and white tape on every pew, please adjust the position of the red and white tape according to your number.
- ◆ Please do not touch the statues. Remember if you have touched something, so may have someone else. The least number of surfaces touched by people the better for yourselves.
- ◆ To request a Mass or Candle Intention(s) please go to the Sacristy to fill out an envelope or form, unless you have arrived with your own envelope or form. Intentions can be posted through the Presbytery door, during the week.
- ◆ There will be a one way system in place for Holy Communion. Please come forward for Holy Communion a row at a time, remembering to leave a metre distance between you and the person in front of you.
- ◆ Sadly, there is no Holy Water at this time. Parishioners are welcome to bring in their bottles of water which Fr. David, will gladly bless.
- ◆ The Fr. Tuite Room, the Joachim Room will not be in operation. If you have to use the toilet, please be prepared to go back in the toilet after Mass to help clean them.
- ◆ Readers please sanitise their hands before touching the Lectionary. Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, please sanitise your hands **AFTER** you have received Holy Communion.

Thank you for your ongoing compliance with guidelines.

Compliance is the only way of ensuring we are safe and are seen to be safe, so protecting the vulnerable.

### The Feast Day of St. Anne and St Joachim Sunday 26th July

Sunday 26th July is the feast of St. Anne and St. Joachim, the parents of Our Lady and the feast of the Parish of St. Anne.

While there is no mention of the names of Our Lady's parents in the Four Gospels, we know that Our Lady would have had to have had a mother and a father. The tradition of these names comes to us from the *Protevangelium* of James, that is *the First Gospel* of James.

Sadly, we won't be able to celebrate the feast in the manner that we would have liked to, but we can be together on the day of the Lord to pray together for one another.

May St. Anne and St. Joachim watch over us and protects as they did the mother of God's only Son.
