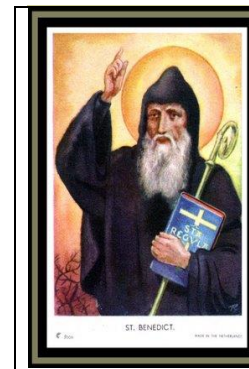

St Benedict, Patron Saint of Europe – Feast Day 11th July (480-547)

Born in Norica, Italy and educated in Rome. He chose to live a solitary life and eventually organised a form of monastic life in twelve monasteries, where the monks who followed him devoted their lives to work and prayer. He also formed the great abbey on Monte Cassino. Because of his influence in the formation of Christendom in the Middle Ages, Pope St Paul VI proclaimed him the Patron of Europe.

Allocation is a first come, first serve, once maximum number has been reached we will be offering a “reserve list”, so if you know you are unable to attend please let us know as soon as possible. Reservations for weekend Masses will be available from the Thursday before and you will not be able to book several weeks at a time, you will only be able to book each weekend.

The strict guidelines already in place will still need to be followed and the Stewards will be there to help reinforce the guidelines:

- It has been requested that you do not “Church-Hop”. This means that if you are attending Mass at OLA & SJV (you can attend both Churches as they are one Parish) you are asked not to attend Mass at another Church, this is purely to reduce the chance of the virus spreading.
- If you are displaying Covid-19 symptoms, you must not enter the church grounds.
- Please queue outside the church observing social distancing
- Please arrive at the Church 15 minutes before Mass (but not before this at OLA on Tuesday & Thursday at present as School are using it for the children to queue. Once School holidays start this will change).
- Before you enter the Church a Steward will take your name and contact details (during weekday Masses). This information will be stored in a secure place for 3 weeks and then destroyed, this is purely for track and trace purposes.
- You will then be asked to put on your face covering and sanitise your hands before entering Church.
- A collection plate/box will be available for you to leave an offering, if you wish.

- The Steward will show you to an allocated seat, unfortunately due to regulations you cannot “pick your own seat”. Once in that seat you must stay there, you **cannot** kneel and you **cannot** walk around the Church
- Mass will be quite different to what you are used to and more will be explained when you arrive.
- One main change will be Communion, Fr Sebastian or Fr Emmanuel will tell you when Communion will take place, at this time a Steward will step forward and tell you when you can go up to Communion, you must leave your face covering on, and the Priest will also be wearing one. You must extend your arms as far as possible and receive communion into your hand, once you have received Communion you must step away and then you can remove the face covering to take Communion.
- Toilets are CLOSED
- Please follow the directions given to you by the stewards at all times; these are for your safety.
- You **cannot** venerate before or touch the statues in the Church
- A steward will be allocated by the candles, they will light a candle at your request, you **cannot** pray before the candles.
- Once Mass has finished you must exit the Church as indicated by the signs and Stewards (this will be the same system as currently in place for Private Prayer). Sanitising your hands as you leave.
