Born, Birgitta Birgersdotter in Uppland, Sweden. She was a Wife and Mother to eight children, one of them being St Catherine of Sweden. After her husband died dedicated her life to God and was the founder of the Briggettines Nuns. She wrote many works of ascetical and mystical subjects. She died in Rome in 1373. She is named as one of the six Patron Saints of Europe, she is the most celebrated saint of Sweden
