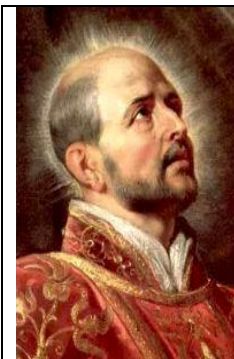

St Ignatius of Loyola (1491-1556)

Feast Day: 31st July

Born in Loyola, Spain, he was a dedicated soldier whose glorious career was stopped short by injury, whilst recovery from his injury he was given the book *Lives of Christ and Saints*, inspired by the regime of the Saints he started his conversion. He studied Theology in Paris and began to gather followers and with them he founded the Society of Jesus in Rome which is dedicated to the greater glory of God and to the service of the Church, in total obedience to the Pope.
