

## Church Offerings

Like all charities, the Church relies on the support of her members. Anyone who is involved with a charitable organisation at this moment in time will be well aware of the financial short falls they are experiencing due to the Coronavirus pandemic.

If we look at the parish of Corpus Christi as an example; just comparing the offertory gifts given from January to August 2019, to January to August 2020 we have a short fall of approximately £8,500. This does not include other income from the likes of the Lottery, Tea & Coffee mornings etc.

As a charity, the Church, like all Charities is not here to make a profit. We are here with a Mission. It is important however, that those who share the Church's Mission know how much their help is needed.

Some parishioners have been very kind and were continually giving through Standing Orders throughout the Lockdown period. Thank you for your support and generosity.

As Parishioners continue to return to Mass, and old familiar faces are reappearing, we are asking for your help and understanding while remaining sensitive to those whose financial circumstance may have changed.

While you weren't able to attend Mass due to the Lockdown, the Church bills; Gas, Electricity, Rates, Insurance, Salaries, etc... continued to come in. We are asking you therefore, if you are in a position to give what you have missed? If so, thank you!

## Stay Alert! Stay Safe!

To those individuals who are coming to Mass, please remember the following key points:

- ◆ Please sanitise your hands when entering and leaving the church.
- ◆ There will be no Mass/Hymn Books or Missalettes. Newsletters will be available, but must be taken home.
- ◆ Please leave a metre distance between each household or Common Households while seated. In Corpus Christi Church, one metre equals two chairs. In St. Anne's Church, there is a metre length red and white tape on every pew, please adjust the position of the red and white tape according to your number.
- ◆ Please do not touch the statues. Remember if you have touched something, so may have someone else. The least number of surfaces touched by people the better for yourselves.
- ◆ To request a Mass or Candle Intention(s) please go to the Sacristy to fill out an envelope or form, otherwise post your Intentions through the Presbytery door, during the week.
- ◆ There will be a one way system in place for Holy Communion. Please come forward for Holy Communion a row at a time, remembering to leave a metre distance between you and the person in front of you.
- ◆ There is no Holy Water at this time. Parishioners are welcome to bring in their bottles of water which Fr. David, will gladly bless.
- ◆ If you have to use the toilet, please be prepared to go back in the toilet after Mass to help clean them.
- ◆ Readers please sanitise their hands before touching the Lectionary.
- ◆ Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, please sanitise your hands **AFTER** you have received Holy Communion.

Thank you for your ongoing compliance with guidelines.

Compliance is the only way of ensuring we are safe and are seen to be safe, so protecting the vulnerable.

## The Power of Prayer

St. Monica, the mother of St. Augustine was a Christian mother. She prayed like all mothers do for her children. Monica prayed especially for Augustine who did not share his mother's Christian faith or way of life. Augustine's life was less than perfect.

After many years and many tears and much praying, Augustine eventually became a Christian and a great leader in the Faith. His works are still being read and used today.

When Monica was dying in Italy, the family wanted to return their mother back to Africa, to Tunisia. Monica's immortal words that she told them are still used today and inscribed on many tombstones.

*Bury me anywhere, she told them, but always remember me at the Altar.*

As we remember these two saints this week, Monica on the 27th and Augustine on 28th, may we always remember our beloved dead during Mass and in our prayers.
