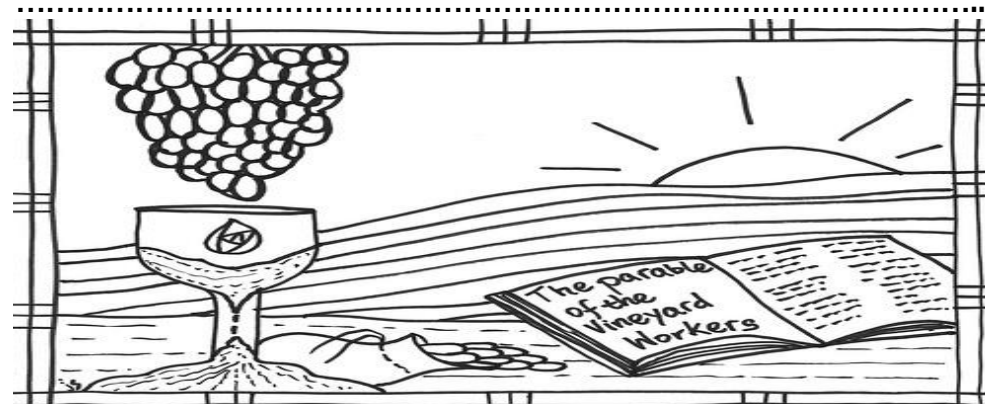

Preface of Ordinary Time - Eucharistic Prayer III



Feast of St Pio of Pietrelcina, (also known as St Padre Pio)

Feast Day 23<sup>rd</sup> September

Born Francesco Forgione in Pietrelcina on May 25<sup>th</sup> 1887. He was the second of seven children born to peasant farmers, who were deeply religious. From an early age he could see guardian angles and poke whim Jesus and Mary, which he thought as normal and everyone was able to do. At the age of 10 he told his parents he wanted to become a Friar, his parents supported this, so much so his Father moved to America to work, to send money home to pay for his education. He became a Novitiate at the age of 15. He first felt/noticed the stigmata on the 20<sup>th</sup> September 1916.

His famous advice is "Pray, hope and don't worry"

He died on September 23<sup>rd</sup> 1968 with over 100,000 people attending his funeral. Pope John Paul II declared his a Saint in 2002.
