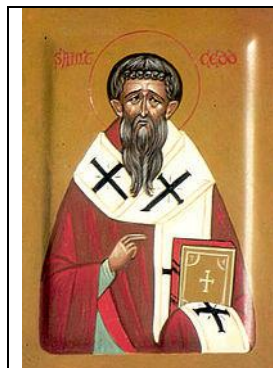
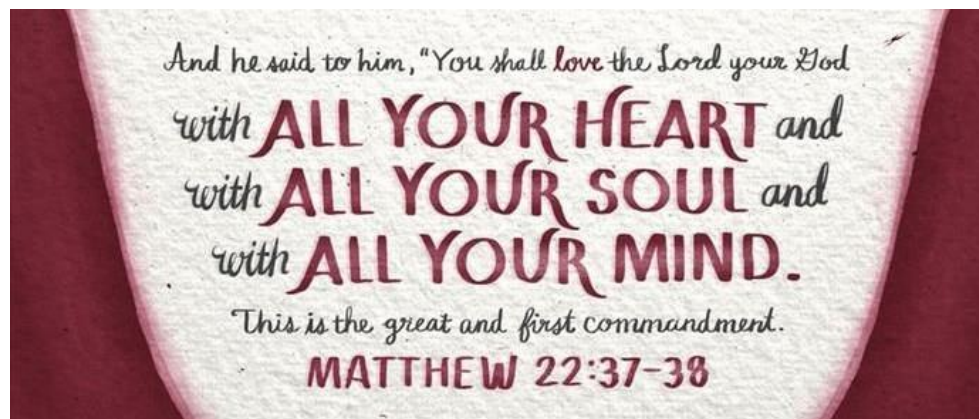

Preface of Ordinary Time - Eucharistic Prayer II



St Cedd , Bishop (620 -664)

Feast Day: 26th October

The eldest of four anglo-Saxon brothers (including St Chad, Cynibil and Caelin), all of whom were trained by St Aidan of Lindisfarne and became monks and priests in 7th century England. He was bishop to the East Saxons at Bradwell and with his See at Othona. Cedd founded several monasteries, including Tilbury and Lavingham. In 664, Cedd was an interpreter at the Synod of Whitby and accepted Oswiu's adoption of Roman usage. Cedd died that year at Lavingham of the plague.
