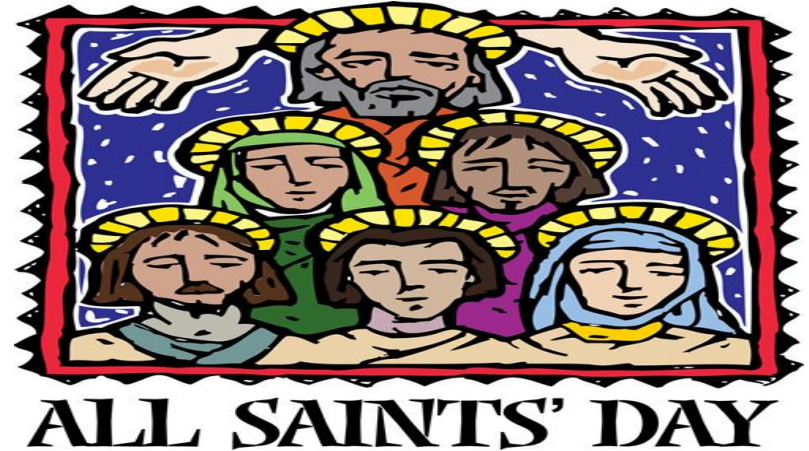



	<p>St Charles Borromeo (1538-1584) Feast Day: 4th November Patron Saint of Bishops, Catechists, Cardinals, Seminarians, spiritual leaders, Born in the Castle of Arona on Lake Maggiore to a noble family. He was the third child of six. His life changed when as a young man his Uncle Giovanni Angelo Medici became Pope Pius IV, whereupon he invited his nephew to join him in Rome where he appointed him a cardinal deacon and a full time advisor to his Uncle. He was ordained a Priest in Sept 1563 and 3 months later was a bishop. He spent his life promoting learning and renewing the life of the clergy. He established seminaries and schools and. He died at 46 in 1584</p>
