COVID UPDATE: Third National Lockdown. We are very fortunate that this time Churches are allowed to remain open but we will therefore be under more scrutiny and must ask you to follow the regulations more stringently (anyone caught breaking these rules by the authorities, may be personally liable to a fine of up to £6,400.00). Stewards are posted around the Church, to ensure your safety and regulations are observed, we therefore remind you of the following: -

- You must not socialise with people outside your family or social bubble inside or outside of the Church.
- Once you are shown to your seat you cannot leave it, unless instructed by a Steward.
- You must remain, where possible, 2 metres apart from anyone outside your bubble
- Face coverings are to remain on at all times.
- Toilets are closed (except in an emergency)
- You are asked to leave the Church when instructed by the Stewards, this may take longer than usual to allow social distancing, which must be observed at all times.
- You must leave the Church Grounds without delay, due to the legal restrictions you cannot socialise in the car park either.

Many of our parishioners fall into a High Risk Category and therefore ask that if you know someone who many just need a bit of shopping done or even just a phone call please contact us (our home phone numbers are in this bulletin and we will arrange this for them). Also, if you would like to volunteer to help with the shopping or a phone call please also contact us and we will "buddy" you up. May God protect us all.
