Ministers of the Word (Readers)

It maybe that we weren't listening properly or concentrating as we should or it could be that you weren't as clear as you could have been (remember diction and annunciation are just as important as is volume) so please can you help us by leading us with the response, **every time**. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.

Preparing for Death

One of the prayers used during a Requiem Mass reminds the mourners that they too are most certainly to follow their deceased loved one. The mourners as indeed all of us are reminded to use God's good Grace to make ready for that last hour by a devout and holy life and to protect us against a sudden and unprovided death.

Preparing for end of life seems to be a thing that has caught the media. There are so many adverts on T.V. asking us to remember certain charities in our Wills and how to unlock our fixed assets or how to have a no fuse funeral.

Choosing an Undertaker is one of those important decisions the family will have to consider. Often families will choose an Undertaker based on past experiences or recommendations. Other families maybe persuaded by the number of Offices on the High Street, and imagine that they must be a good choice. However, just because a company has many offices it doesn't mean that they have the number of staff and cars to support their outfit. Therefore often families will be made to wait three sometimes even four weeks before they can bury their loved one.

Waiting a long time to bury a loved one can be very upsetting to a grieving family. Please therefore consider all options when choosing an Undertaker. Keeping it local and choosing a smaller company often has greater advantages.
