February – A month to remember all our lost babies.

For the past few years we have dedicated the month of February to remembering babies we have lost before, during or just after birth. Thanks to our pastoral care team, we have a small shrine where those who have lost babies can light a candle and write a message in memory.

This year, we will keep to our tradition, but we will need to do it a little differently. The shrine will be in front of the altar rather than to the side of the church and we will be unable to offer you candles or pen and paper to write. If, however, you have lost a baby and would like to remember him or her in the church this year, please feel free to bring in your own symbol of your baby's life – maybe his or her name on a slip of paper, a photo or something that belonged to baby for the short time he or she was with you – and as you leave church, you can place it at the shrine.

At every Mass during February, those who have lost babies will be remembered.



Don't forget that we also have a plaque to our Lost Babies in our memorial garden where you can place plants, flowers or symbols at any time.
