During Lent we are encouraged to focus on the 3 Pillars of Lent; Prayer, Fasting and Almsgiving. These can be easily married up with the 3 fold ministry of Christ to help us defeat the human sickness known as self-centeredness.

As Priests, we are called to offer sacrifices; prayer accompanies any sacrifice.

As Prophets, we are called to proclaim God's Word; fasting makes us learn to live not by bread but by every Word that comes from the mouth of God.

As Kings we are called to serve and not to be served; almsgiving makes us learn to share our good fortune with others; the more we give, the more we receive.

May God enrich us each day with Faith, Hope and Charity.
