**MASS ON ASH WEDNESDAY 17<sup>th</sup> Feb - OLA at 10.00am AND SJV at 6.30pm.** To receive ashes, please stand as you would for communion. Instead of marking a cross on your forehead father will sprinkle ashes on the head of each person without saying anything.

**AS WEDNESDAY IS THE START OF LENT.** Lent is the traditional season of renewal and repentance in Christ. It has been prescribed that Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are to be observed as days of fast and abstinence. Fasting means that the amount of food we eat is considerably reduced. Abstinence means that we give up a particular kind of food or drink or form of amusement. Those over eighteen are bound by the law of fasting until the beginning of their sixtieth year, while all over fourteen are bound by the law of abstinence

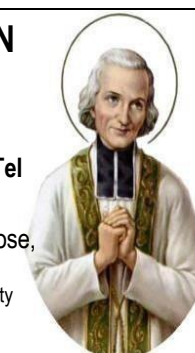

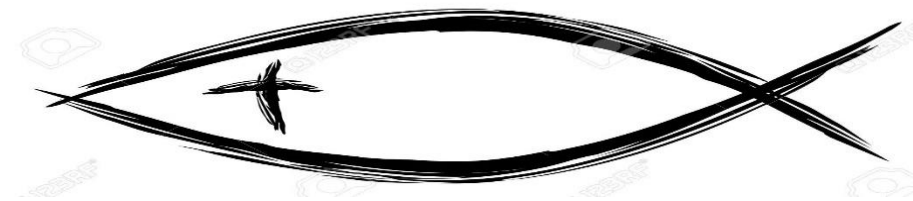
