Dear Parishioners

Thank you for your continued support to our Lenten Programme. It's clear from Ash Wednesday attendance and for the attendance at Mass over Lent, that more people are confident in returning to Church. Thankfully we will be able to have our Easter celebrations for Holy Week. As you remember, last year all these had to be celebrated in empty churches. It is important that we make safe and proper arrangements for the weeks ahead and we will be organising a booking system again for the Easter celebrations and also the Bishops have asked us to look at ways in which the ceremonies will be celebrated with dignity, but within a shorter time span so that we are not in groups for too long. The simpler Liturgy worked very well on Ash Wednesday and I know it will again, particularly on Good Friday. We will let you have further details next week as soon as they are available. There is still of course the option to watch over the livestream if this is still the safest option.

I want to encourage you to be positive about the vaccination and to receive it when you are offered the chance. The Holy Father has encouraged us to have the vaccine for our own health and for the health of the whole community. Also, we could support the campaign to distribute the vaccine to the poorer nations of the world (see details overleaf).

The first of the parent's resources is now available for those whose children will be taking the Sacraments and we will be looking at Prayer and Baptism. My talk on Prayer is now available and anyone who wants to improve their knowledge of Faith can also use these resources as they are not just for parents.

There will also be Confessions available every Saturday morning at 10.00am - 11.00am and every Saturday evening at 7.00pm. Could we ask that people be

I want to encourage you to support us in our collection of parish data so that we can get our records up to date which will help us when things begin to get back to normal and we can restart many of our parish groups. It is going to be important to build our parish again and communication will be a huge part of this. We need you all to take seriously the request to give us your up to date details, either by using a printed form from the back of the Church, or by filling in the database section on the parish website. If you have filled a census form in the past, we will use this with your permission, unless we hear otherwise, but you may wish to submit an updated version. This information will only be for the parish use and focused on the Sacraments. It will not be used for any other reasons and not shared with any other party. We will presume that you are happy for us to continue to keep your details and if you have any objections please let us know.

With more people attending Mass, I think it is the right time to ask younger families to make the effort to start coming back to Church.

Thanks for all the new cleaning volunteers. We have had a great response. There is a rota available in the Library.

As we prepare for the reopening of many aspects of our life, please think of ways that you can become involved again in the parish community. We have built up a great community here and we will all need to contribute again to build up the parish life and make it even stronger. Perhaps, what we have missed will help us appreciate what we have.

We have a large number of funerals this week. Please pray for all those who have died and their families who mourn their loss at this difficult time.

Sacrament of Reconciliation

The Bishops have asked that all should make a Perfect Act of Contrition. Perfect contrition (or a Contrition of Charity) is true and real sorrow for our sins which is created when we realise the immense love of God for each one of us. We express this contrition when we realise how we offend God by our sinful words, deeds and omissions in contrast to the immeasurable love and mercy that He continually shows us.

This requires us to be contrite of heart for what we have done, know and be overwhelmed by the love and mercy of God for His children, and to approach this grace with humility and resolution not to sin again.

An Act of Contrition

My God, I am sorry for my sins with all my heart. In choosing to do wrong and failing to do good, I have sinned against you whom I should love above all things. I firmly intend, with your help, to do penance, to sin no more, and to avoid whatever leads me to sin. Our Saviour Jesus Christ suffered and died for us. In his name, my God, have mercy.
