## FOURTH SUNDAY OF LENT (Year B) 14<sup>th</sup> March 2021

Dear Parishioners

Firstly, we want to wish all mothers a Happy Mother's Day! I hope families have a chance to spoil their mum's. We have bookmarks for all our mums at Mass today.

We are now making our arrangements for Holy Week. On Palm Sunday we will have an extra Mass at 10.30am at Christ the King and an extra Mass at St Augustine's at 9.00am. For Holy Thursday night, we will have Mass at 7.00pm. There will be no Watching until Midnight under the present regulations but after Mass we will have Watching for an hour which you can watch over the livestream. On Good Friday we will have services at 1.00pm, 3.00pm and 5.00pm at Christ the King and at 1.00pm and 3.00pm at St Augustine's. For Easter Saturday night we will just have a Mass at 8.00pm. Again, this will have to be simplified and on Easter Sunday we will have 9.00am, 10.30am and 12 Noon at Christ the King and 9.00am and 10.30am at St Augustine's. We will have a booking system, and this will open for bookings on Monday 15<sup>th</sup> March. Please only book a place if you are certain to come and if your plans change please either cancel on the system or phone the office. **See overleaf for booking links.** There is still of course the option to watch over the livestream if this is still the safest option.

I want to encourage you to be positive about the vaccination and to receive it when you are offered the chance. The Holy Father has encouraged us to have the vaccine for our own health and for the health of the whole community. Also, we could support the campaign to distribute the vaccine to the poorer nations of the

With more people attending Mass, I think it is the right time to ask younger families to make the effort to start coming back to Church.

Jithin Titto, our Seminarian who has been in the parish the last 8 weeks has returned to his studies at Oscott College. We thank him for his involvement in the parish and assure him of our prayers and good wishes. I know he will be back to visit again.

We have our Gift Aid envelopes available at the end of Mass this weekend. These are available in the Library for current Gift Aiders. You will know that our finances have been badly affected by the Pandemic, so perhaps consider joining the Gift Aid Scheme when we ask for new donors over the next few weeks. The Parish is also piloting a card payment machine for cashless donations. These will be available this weekend and can be used to make a donation to CAFOD so that people can get used to using them. Why not think about it as your way of giving to the Church. We will give fuller details and a demonstration over the next few weeks.

The Pioneers are having a Mass on Monday evening at 7.00pm with Rosary at 6.30pm in honour of St Patrick. All welcome. We have an extra Mass on Wednesday at 12 Noon for St Patrick's Day as well as the 7.00am and the 9.30am at St Augustine's.

## **Make an Act of Spiritual Communion**

This can be done whilst you watch a live stream of Mass being offered by saying the following prayer:

*"My Jesus, I believe that You are present in the Most Holy Sacrament.  
I love You above all things, and I desire to receive You into my soul.  
Since I cannot at this moment receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart.  
I embrace You as if You were already there and unite myself wholly to You. Never permit me to be separated from You."*

## **Sacrament of Reconciliation**

The Bishops have asked that all should make a Perfect Act of Contrition. Perfect contrition (or a Contrition of Charity) is true and real sorrow for our sins which is created when we realise the immense love of God for each one of us. We express this contrition when we realise how we offend God by our sinful words, deeds and omissions in contrast to the immeasurable love and mercy that He continually shows us.

This requires us to be contrite of heart for what we have done, know and be overwhelmed by the love and mercy of God for His children, and to approach this grace with humility and resolution not to sin again.

An Act of Contrition

***My God, I am sorry for my sins with all my heart. In choosing to do wrong and failing to do good, I have sinned against you whom I should love above all things. I firmly intend, with your help, to do penance, to sin no more, and to avoid whatever leads me to sin. Our Saviour Jesus Christ suffered and died for us. In his name, my God, have mercy.***
