Dear Parishioners

We are fast approaching Holy Week and Easter. Next week is Palm Sunday and we have arranged extra masses to increase capacity over the Easter season. All the details are on the Newsletter, the website and the purple sheet, along with details of which days you will need to book for. The ceremonies will be very familiar, but will be in a shortened form to keep within the guidelines of not staying too long in church. We will be relying on the help of stewards and cleaners, so please offer your help if you can. Please contact the office for details. We will have a briefing meeting for the stewards for about 15 minutes at 6.00pm on this Thursday evening, 25th March. Please try and come along if you are stewarding.

On Palm Sunday we will have an extra Mass at 10.30am at Christ the King and an extra Mass at St Augustine's at 9.00am. For Holy Thursday night, we will have Mass at 7.00pm. There will be no Watching until Midnight under the present regulations but after Mass we will have Watching for an hour which you can watch over the livestream. On Good Friday we will have services at 1.00pm, 3.00pm and 5.00pm at Christ the King and at 1.00pm and 3.00pm at St Augustine's. For Easter Saturday night we will just have a Mass at 8.00pm. Again, this will have to be simplified and on Easter Sunday we will have 9.00am, 10.30am and 12 Noon at Christ the King and 9.00am and 10.30am at St Augustine's. Please only book a place if you are certain to come and if your plans change please either cancel on the system or phone the office. **See overleaf for booking links.** There is still of course the option to watch over the livestream if this is still the safest option.

11.00am and every Saturday evening at 7.00pm. Could we ask that people be sensible over the time taken for Confession and just keep to a maximum of 5 minutes for the safety of all concerned. With more people attending Mass, I think it is the right time to ask younger families to make the effort to start coming back to Church.

This Tuesday, the Bishops have asked us to join in with the National Day of Reflection, a year on from the first lockdown. We would like this to be a time of prayer, so on Tuesday after the morning 9.30am Mass we will have a Holy Hour from 10.00am to 11.00am, ending with Benediction and again in the evening from 6.00pm to 7.00pm ending with the Rosary and Benediction. Please try and come along if you can.

I want to encourage you to be positive about the vaccination and to receive it when you are offered the chance. The Holy Father has encouraged us to have the vaccine for our own health and for the health of the whole community. Also, we could support the campaign to distribute the vaccine to the poorer nations of the world (see details overleaf).

We have our Gift Aid envelopes available at the end of Mass this weekend. These are available in the Library for current Gift Aiders. You will know that our finances have been badly affected by the Pandemic, so perhaps consider joining the Gift Aid Scheme when we ask for new donors over the next few weeks. After this weekend the envelopes will be available for collection from the office. Please email or ring up to arrange collection. The Parish is also piloting a card payment machine for cashless donations. These will be available this weekend and can be used to make a donation to CAFOD so that people can get used to using them. Why not think about it as your way of giving to the Church. We will give fuller details and a demonstration over the next few weeks.

Please start thinking of your plans for the Easter services and start booking up to help with our planning.

Make an Act of Spiritual Communion

This can be done whilst you watch a live stream of Mass being offered by saying the following prayer:

*“My Jesus, I believe that You are present in the Most Holy Sacrament.
I love You above all things, and I desire to receive You into my soul.
Since I cannot at this moment receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart.
I embrace You as if You were already there and unite myself wholly to You. Never permit me to be separated from You.”*

Sacrament of Reconciliation

The Bishops have asked that all should make a Perfect Act of Contrition. Perfect contrition (or a Contrition of Charity) is true and real sorrow for our sins which is created when we realise the immense love of God for each one of us. We express this contrition when we realise how we offend God by our sinful words, deeds and omissions in contrast to the immeasurable love and mercy that He continually shows us.

This requires us to be contrite of heart for what we have done, know and be overwhelmed by the love and mercy of God for His children, and to approach this grace with humility and resolution not to sin again.

An Act of Contrition

My God, I am sorry for my sins with all my heart. In choosing to do wrong and failing to do good, I have sinned against you whom I should love above all things. I firmly intend, with your help, to do penance, to sin no more, and to avoid whatever leads me to sin. Our Saviour Jesus Christ suffered and died for us. In his name, my God, have mercy.

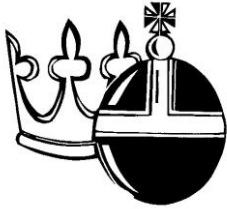
