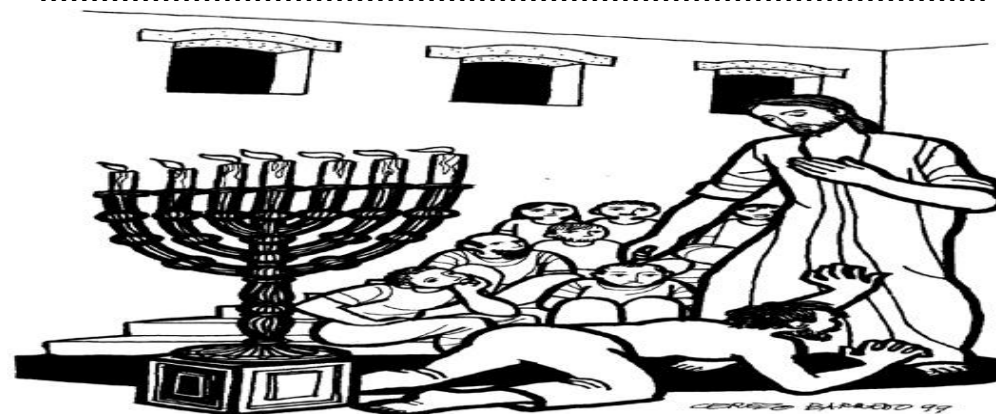

**St Patrick, Patron Saint of Ireland

He is one of the World's most popular saints. He was born in Roman Britain at around the age of 14 he was kidnapped by Irish pirates and taken to Ireland where he was held as a slave for around 6 years when he escaped. After he joined the Priesthood and was made a Bishop he returned to Ireland where he stayed for 40 years until his death. In that time he converted many Irish to Christianity. He died on the 17 March 461 in Saul, the place he had built the first Irish Church.
