Booking a Funeral with the Co-Op

If you have to plan a funeral and you choose to book with the CO-OP Fr. David will ask you to pay upfront in cash, cash only, direct to the Parish the Church's and Minister's Fee, which is currently £170.00. *Why?*

Fr. David is tired of having to chase the Co-op for late payments...

Every Undertaker in Coventry that Corpus Christi and St. Anne's deals with, pays the church and the Minister either on the day or a few days before the funeral.

Since Covid, the Co-op will only pay direct into the parish bank account, (when they remember!) They are the only funeral company who have adopted this policy.

Fr. David would sooner not have the Co-op on site, but if they are your choice, we will accommodate them, but you will have to pay the fee upfront in cash when you come to meet Fr. David; no cheques or transfers. You will also have to make sure that you are not billed for the payment by the Co-op.

Until the Co-op changes its current method of payment with our parishes then this is the way it will be. I apologise for any inconvenience, but Fr. David has had enough with them.

Corpus Christi's Easter Garden Collection

Who are *the friends of the Holy Land*?

The Friends of the Holy Land, is a non-political Christian Charity. Their mission is to secure a resilient and enduring Christian community in the West Bank, Gaza, Israel and Jordan - the part of the world that Christians call the Holy Land At the beginning of the 20th century, Christians made up roughly 29% of the overall population of the Holy Land.

Today they account for less than 2%. Without support, the Holy places of the Bible, the birthplace of Christianity, could become cultural museums with no Christian presence at all.

The focus of their work is providing practical help directly to the most needy and vulnerable of our Christian brothers and sisters through a balance of funding immediate relief of emergency needs and practical small projects to help create a sustainable future in the Holy Land – most importantly to give them HOPE. They have a team of locally based lay and clerical professionals who identify and verify our cases.

Their work is ecumenical. The beneficiaries of their work come from all Christian communities in the Holy Land. Their supporters in the UK come from all denominations of the Christian Faith. They have the backing and blessing of church leaders in England, Wales and Scotland.
