Prayer To St. Joseph, for the Year of St. Joseph

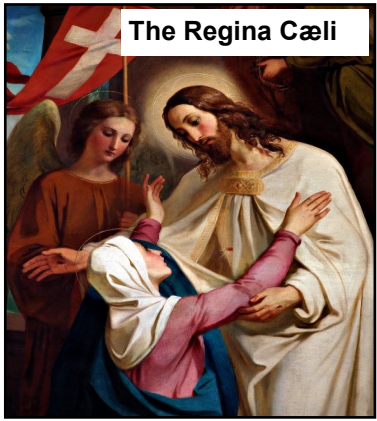
Hail guardian of the Redeemer,

The Feast of St. Joseph the Worker - 1st May
 Pope Francis announced back on December 8th, 2020 a Year of St. Joseph in honour of the 150th anniversary of the saint's proclamation as patron of the universal Church . As a parish we are praying to St. Joseph in a special way.
 The 1st of May is the feast of St. Joseph the Worker. In 1955 Pope Pius XII initiated the feast of St. Joseph the Worker. In the past 1st May, or May Day, had been a day to recognise workers, especially amongst socialists and communists. Pope Pius wanted to elevate the dignity of work beyond the secular ideas of it. By connecting this celebration to St. Joseph, who is an example and patron of workers. Pope Pius drew attention to the fact that work is not simply about the material world; there is a spiritual dimension to it.
 The dignity of work is one of the core principles of Catholic social teaching. Work is part of what it means to be human. In the story of Creation, Adam and Eve were told to care for and cultivate the earth. It is through our work that we participate with God as co-creators. By working, we join in with God's divine act of creation!
St. Joseph, intercede for all workers, but especially for the unemployed. Amen.
