### The Feast of the Ascension of the Lord

Thursday 13th May is the Feast of the Ascension of the Lord.

The Ascension is a Holy Day of Obligation. (*some may view that since Covid, Holydays of Obligation are suspended*)

The Ascension, marks 40 days since the Resurrection.

The Ascension is the second Glorious Mystery of the Rosary and forms a fundamental part of our Faith; when Jesus Ascended to the Father in heaven, he took his place at the Right hand of God the Father Almighty, from that seat he will judge the living and the dead.

The Feast of the Ascension also marks the period of prayer waiting for the out pouring of the Holy Spirit on Pentecost. These nine days of waiting is the first and most important Novena in the Church.
