## The Feast of Pentecost

Next weekend we celebrate the Feast of Pentecost. This feast marks 50 days since the Resurrection.

Pentecost is the Third Glorious Mystery of the Rosary and forms a fundamental part of our Faith; when Jesus Ascended to the Father in heaven, he promised to send another Advocate, another helper.

Jesus sent his disciples back to Jerusalem to wait nine days in prayer for the outpouring of the Holy Spirit. These nine days of waiting are the first and most important Novena in the Church. Between Ascension and Pentecost, the Scriptures tell us:

*"All these with one accord were devoting themselves to prayer together with the women and Mary the mother of Jesus and his brothers..." (Acts 1:14) while they awaited to be "clothed with power from on high." Luke 24:49.*

The Holy Father has invited us to use this time of prayer to focus on Creation; on the Environment and our care for it.

The Holy Spirit is the Lord the giver of life, all life. As we prayer for a deeper trust in God through the sharing of his Holy Spirit may we ask the Holy Spirit to send forth his Spirit and renew the face of the earth.
