Dear Parishioners

This week marks another stage in the Government's Road Map. The Parish Centre will be open on Monday and will have to operate within the guidelines, but it will be good to have the centre open again. It also means that we can increase numbers for baptisms to 30 people for weddings to 30 people and for funerals 50 people. We will still need to have invited people only to these services and families will have to provide a list of those attending along with phone numbers for track and trace purposes. This is a big step forward and we hope things will be back to normal by 21st June. For Sunday Masses at Christ the King we will still have the Library available as an overflow.

We will ask parish groups to consider when they would like to start meeting again, as we can meet inside and can organise people in groups of 6 around a table. Could group leaders please contact me to arrange to speak about opening plans either with the 17th May or 21st June in mind. It may be a good idea to meet up at least once or twice before the summer break to reaffirm some of the groups that have not met for such a long time.

The numbers at Church are gradually increasing and we are pleased to see more of the young families returning each week, especially as we prepare for Holy Communion and Confirmation in the Summer. It is important that we are still sensible and maintain social distancing. Please when you come to Church, don't sit on the end of the bench if the rest of the bench is empty, this will make better use of the space and avoid people crossing over each other. Please sit on the next available seat and stewards will help you. The Diocese has now given permission for pupils to attend school masses and we will start these over the next week or so with children from Christ the King on Tuesday's and children from St

Augustine's on Wednesday's. The children and parishioners will be kept totally separate and use different entrances to avoid any difficulties. We will be giving priority to Year 3 and Year 6 children as they prepare for their Sacraments. The First Confessions will have to be through the school this year and not in the evening with parents as we usually do. The First Confessions for Christ the King will be on Tuesday 15th June at 10.30am and for St Augustine's on Wednesday 16th June at 10.30am. They will be available to watch on the livestream if families want to witness the First Confessions. The Year 6 Confirmations for St Augustine's will be on Saturday 12th June and for Christ the King on Saturday 19th June. First Holy Communion are on the 3rd July for Christ the King and 10th July for St Augustine's. We will be celebrating these Sacraments in a limited way. For Confirmations the candidates will be allowed 8 guests including their Sponsor and for First Holy Communion, 12 guests. This will allow safe use of the church. We will be asking for guest's names in due course, but this is to give you some warning so that you can start thinking about who to invite. For children at non-catholic schools, the First Confessions will be on Tuesday, 1st June at 5.00pm and the First Communion on Sunday 4th July at 3.00pm. There will be a meeting for all parents and children not attending a Catholic school who are preparing for these Sacraments this Tuesday 18th May at 5.00pm in the Library. We will be starting the Youth Group before the summer break with a few special events. We will be writing to Youth Group members from year 7 upwards to let you know about these events over the next couple of weeks. These will all take place after the 21st June when things will be a bit easier. Please remember the Pope's request to pray for an end to the Pandemic.

I love You above all things, and I desire to receive You into my soul.
Since I cannot at this moment receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart.
I embrace You as if You were already there and unite myself wholly to You. Never permit me to be separated from You."*

Sacrament of Reconciliation

The Bishops have asked that all should make a Perfect Act of Contrition. Perfect contrition (or a Contrition of Charity) is true and real sorrow for our sins which is created when we realise the immense love of God for each one of us. We express this contrition when we realise how we offend God by our sinful words, deeds and omissions in contrast to the immeasurable love and mercy that He continually shows us.

This requires us to be contrite of heart for what we have done, know and be overwhelmed by the love and mercy of God for His children, and to approach this grace with humility and resolution not to sin again.

An Act of Contrition

My God, I am sorry for my sins with all my heart. In choosing to do wrong and failing to do good, I have sinned against you whom I should love above all things. I firmly intend, with your help, to do penance, to sin no more, and to avoid whatever leads me to sin. Our Saviour Jesus Christ suffered and died for us. In his name, my God, have mercy.
